THE DECREE ...

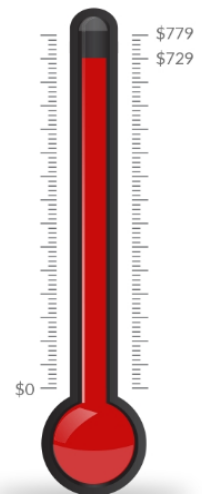
The Archbishop of Ottawa Terrence Prendergast, S.J. affirmed in a decree issued April 25, 2019 that a new parish of St Faustina be created from the extinctive union of the parishes of St Margaret Mary and St Edith Stein to be effective July 1, 2019.

The new parish name of St Faustina will help us forge our new identity as a “Divine Mercy Parish” and aid in our quest to promote our community to others.

Our Mortgage Highlights

- ❖ Balance as of June 12, 2019.....\$276,000.00
- ❖ Monthly mortgage payment @4.5%.....\$2,380.00
- ❖ By the end of June, our additional payments have totalled \$160,000 since we began in November 2018.

Fund-Raising

Brad Chippior reports that collectively we are contributing on average \$6,500 + per month to the land acquisition.

Based on our fund-raising and pledges so far, we are **within \$50,000** of paying off the mortgage on the land. Brad predicts we can achieve our goal by December 2021. A fantastic achievement to have done this **within three years!**

If you have automatic withdrawals from your bank account to pay your bills, taxes, or mortgage, then you already understand the PAD principle.

Pre-authorized Debit - makes a world of difference for the parish in terms of financial planning, and budgeting. A system for pre-authorized debits makes it easy for parishioners to give even when they can't make it to church or for times when you find yourself without cash.
