Priest: Show us, O Lord, your mercy.

All: **And grant us your salvation.**

and **on earth peace to people of good will.**

we glorify you,
we give you thanks **for your great glory,**
Lord God, heavenly King,
O God, almighty Father.

you are seated at the right hand of the Father,

NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty,

of the Father.

dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,
the Lord, the giver of life,
who proceeds from the Father and the Son,
who with the Father and the Son
is adored and glorified,
who has spoken through the prophets.

I believe in one,
holy, catholic and apostolic Church.

I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins
and I look forward

to the resurrection of the dead
and the life of the world to come.

APOSTLES' CREED:

I believe in God, the Father almighty,
Creator of heaven and earth,

and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,
born of the Virgin Mary,
suffered under Pontius Pilate,
was crucified, died and was buried;
he descended **into hell**;
on the third day he rose again **from the dead**;
he ascended into heaven,
and is seated at the right hand
of **God** the Father **almighty**;
from there he will come to judge
the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic
Church,
the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,
the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.

Holy, holy, holy Lord God of **hosts**,

Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.

MYSTERY OF FAITH (Memorial Acclamation)

Priest: The mystery of faith:

**When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we
proclaim your death, O Lord, until you come again.**

INVITATION TO COMMUNION:

*Priest: Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who
takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those
called to the supper of the Lamb.*

All: Lord, I am not worthy
that you should enter under my roof, but only say
the word and **my soul** shall be healed.

PRAYER OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION:

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the
most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all
things and I desire to receive You into my soul.
Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally,
come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace
You as if You were already there, and unite myself
wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated
from You. Amen.
