All Souls Day Indulgences

A plenary indulgence is granted to the Christian faithful who devoutly visit a church or an oratory on All Souls Day, November 2, and who prays the Lord's Prayer and the Creed. The other normal conditions apply – these are listed below. Plenary indulgences are applicable only for the souls in purgatory.

"Handbook of Indulgences", Grant #67, p. 91.

An indulgence is [also] granted the Christian faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only [praying] mentally, for the dead. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls in purgatory. This indulgence is a plenary one from November 1 through November 8 and can be gained on each one of these days. On the other days of the year this indulgence is a partial one. The other normal conditions apply – these are listed below.

"Handbook of Indulgences", Grant #13, p. 47.

The normal conditions for a Plenary Indulgence are:

1. Sacramental Confession and absolution (*on the days immediately before or after performing the indulgenced act, if that cannot be done on the day of performing the act itself*).
2. Reception of Holy Communion (*preferably on the day of performing the act itself*)
3. Detachment from all sin.
4. Prayer for the Pope's intentions.

The Holy Rosary is prayed before Mass on the first and third Sundays of the month in Alva and every Sunday before Mass in Cherokee.

The Lateran Basilica

The Lateran Basilica is located in Rome, on land once owned by the Laterani family, was dedicated by Pope St. Sylvester I and honored as the episcopal seat of the pope as bishop of Rome. According to an inscription which Pope Clement XII placed on the façade, this basilica is the "mother and head of all churches of Rome and the world". It was the residence of the popes from the 4th c. until their moving to Avignon (1309). It was the site of five ecumenical councils. Pope Innocent X commissioned the present structure in 1646. Beneath it's high altar rests the remains of the small wooden table on which, according to tradition, St. Peter celebrated Mass.
