

CARETAKERS RESTORATION and CREATION OF GREEN SPACE

The many concrete foundations and driveways left from the Nike site (including the Caretakers area) has limited a large section of the park to be fragmented, disjointed and unusable space. There is little opportunity to practice riding/driving in 'the open', where uninterrupted land allows for a safe and enjoyable experience. The impervious surfaces are environmentally obnoxious, create safety hazards, and are detrimental to the health of native soils and surfaces. We are eager to remove these hazards and restore the park to healthier surfaces and useable space.

Grade and seed bed preparation:	40 hours @ \$95/hour:	\$3,800
