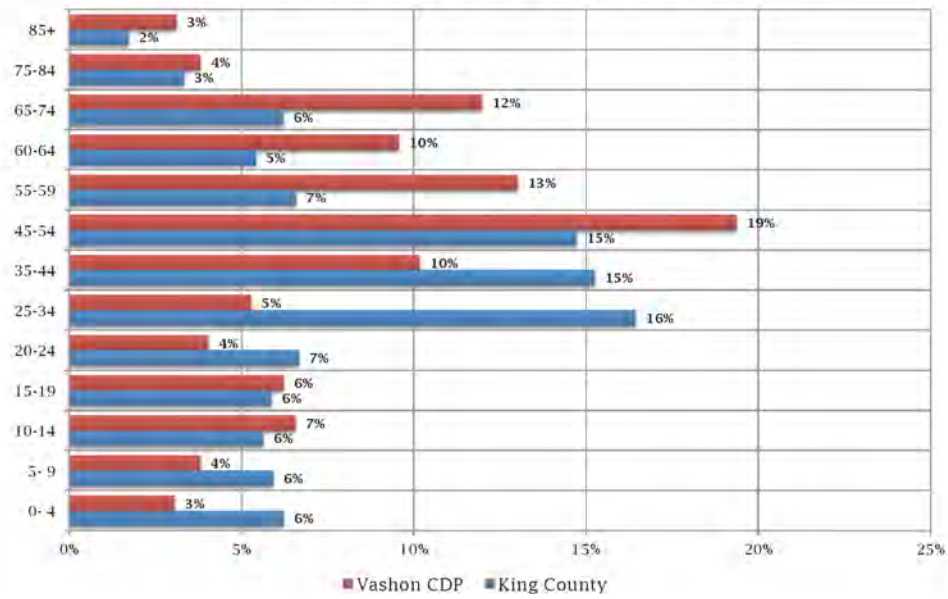
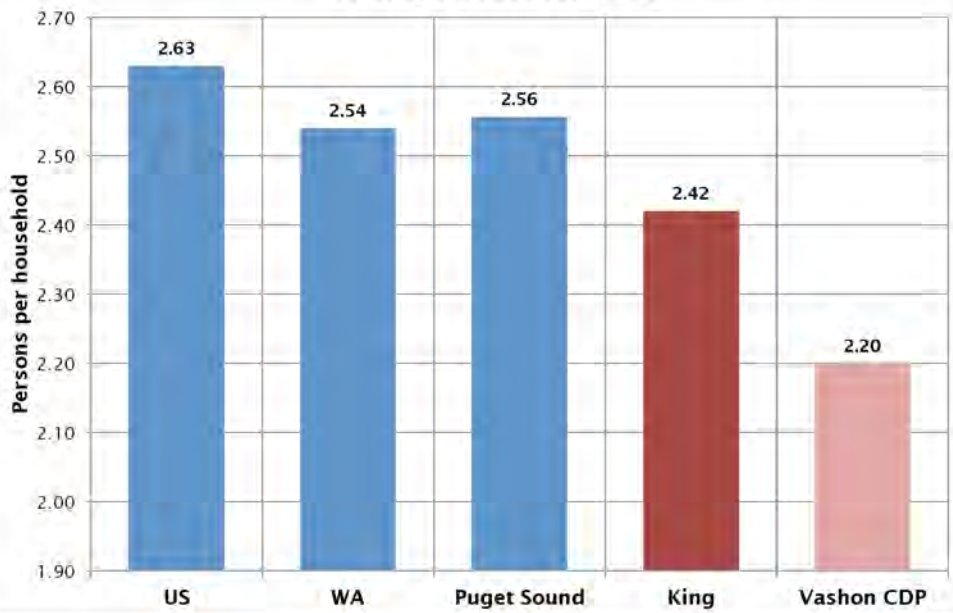
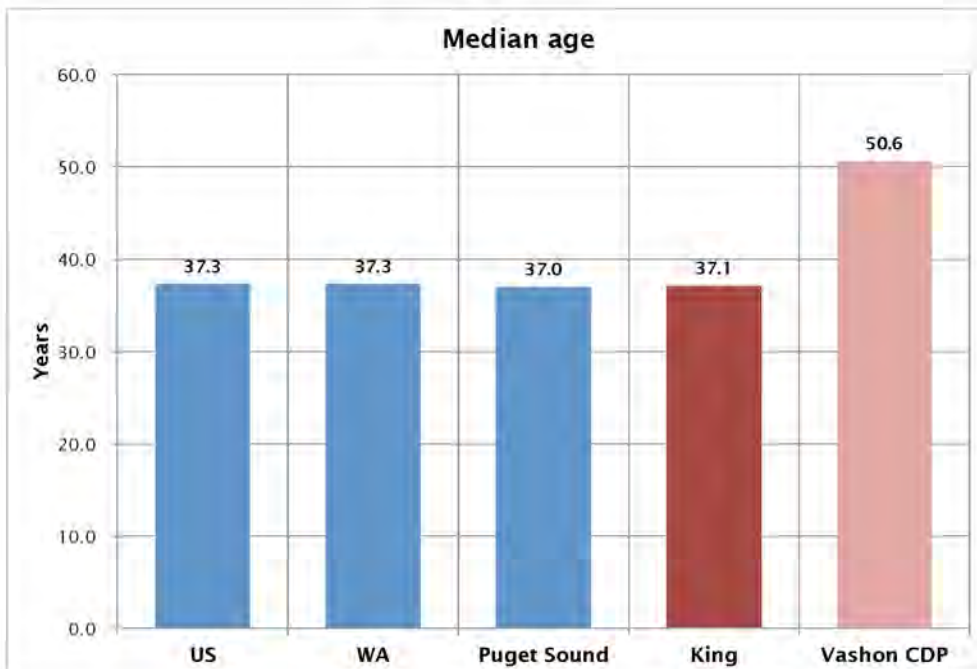
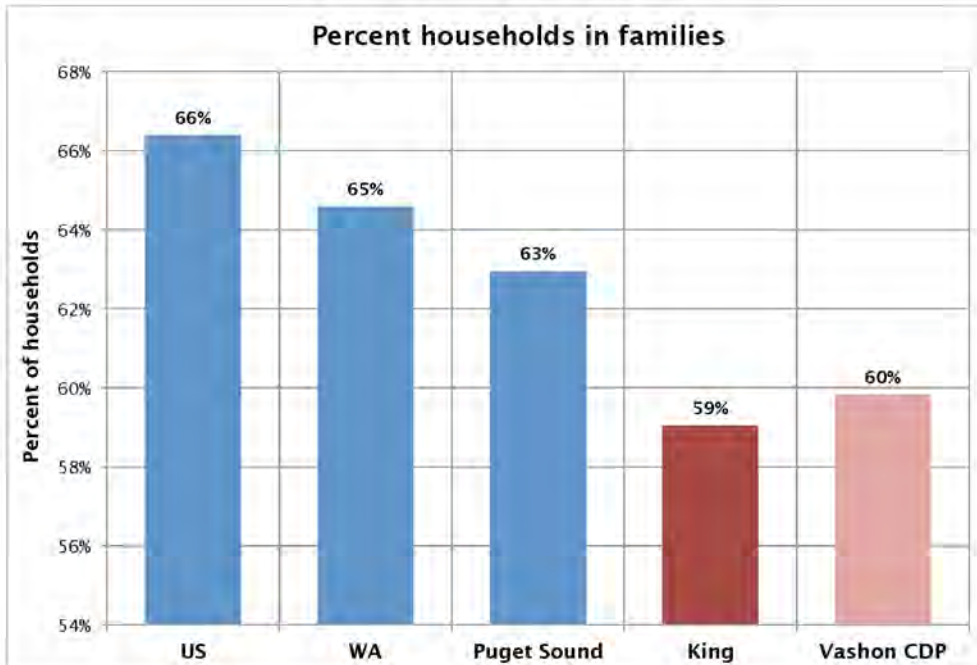


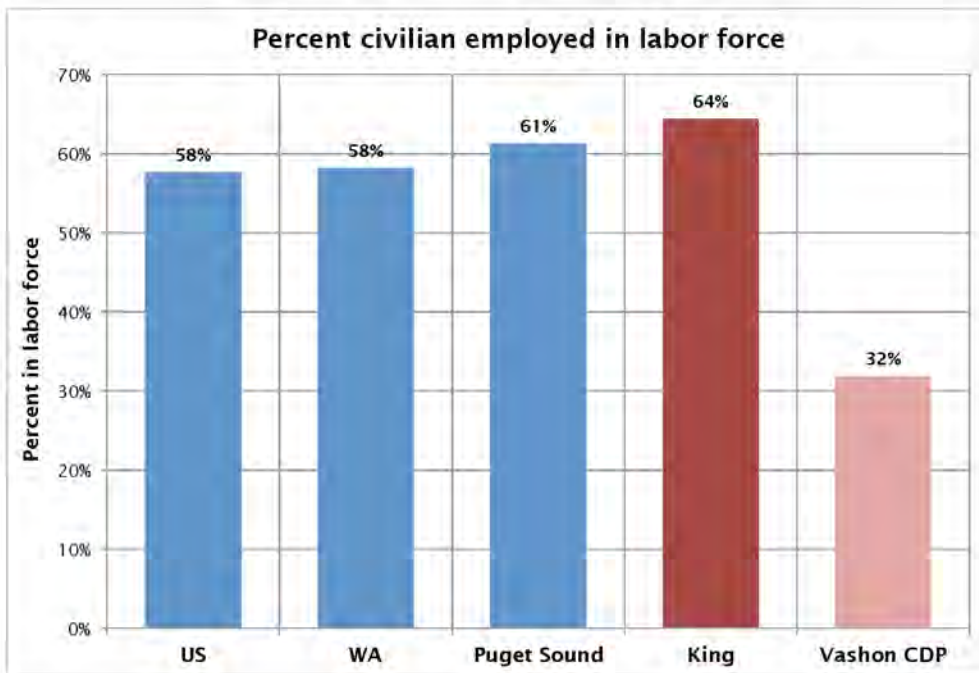
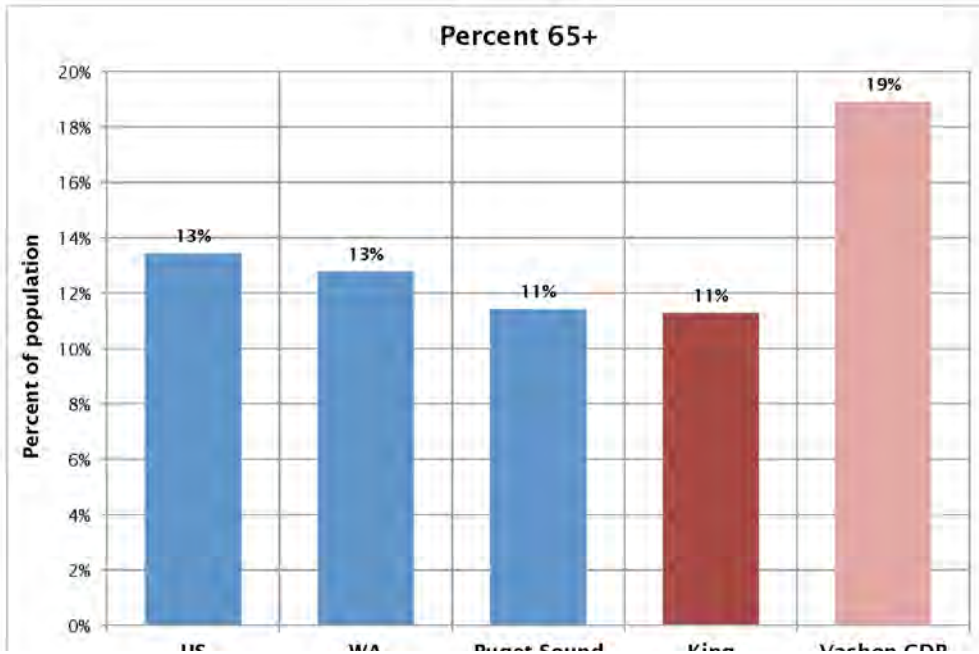
Age distribution Vashon/King County 2013

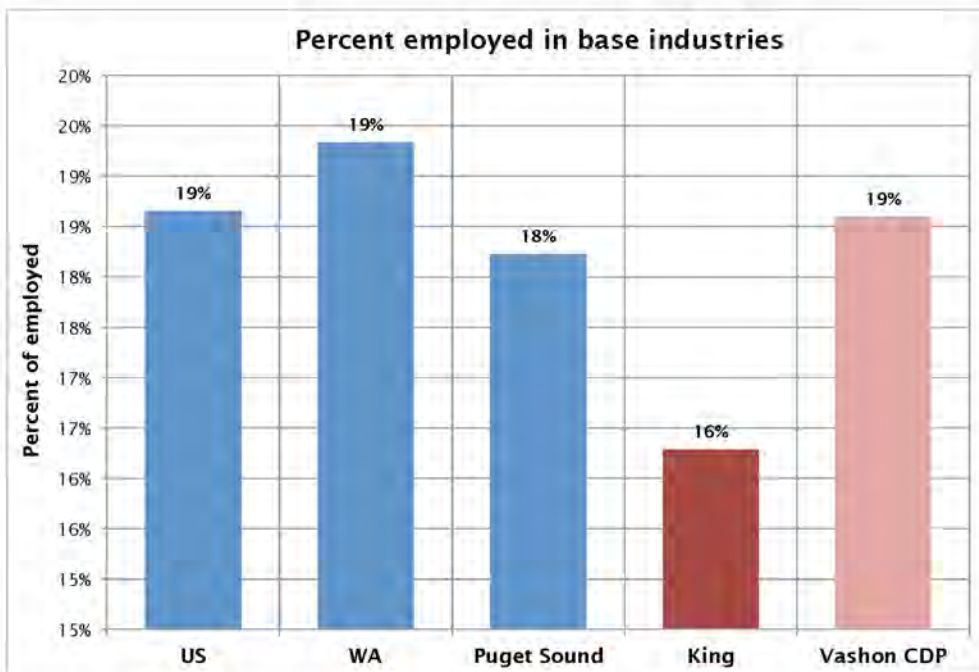
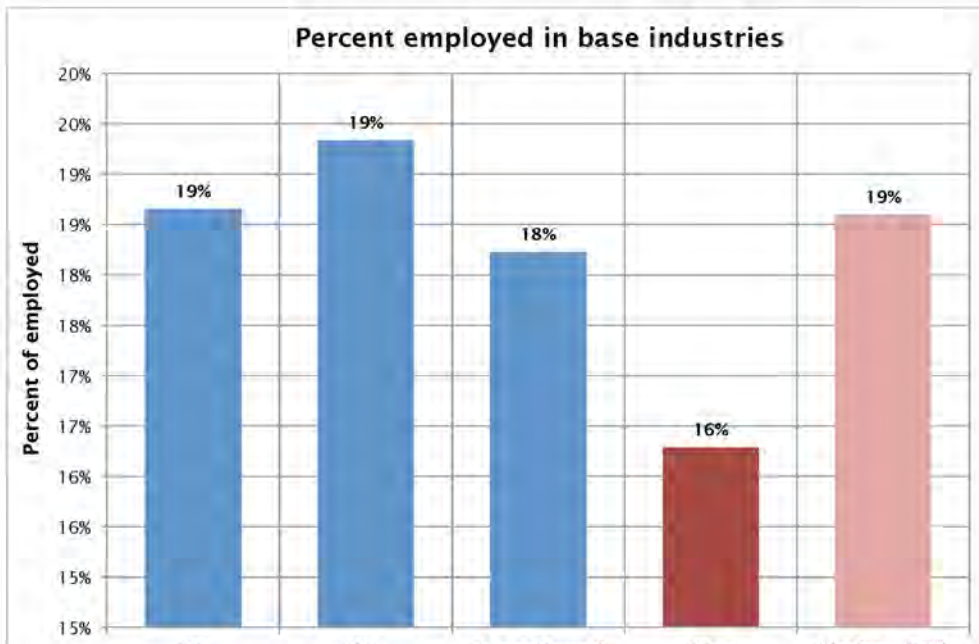


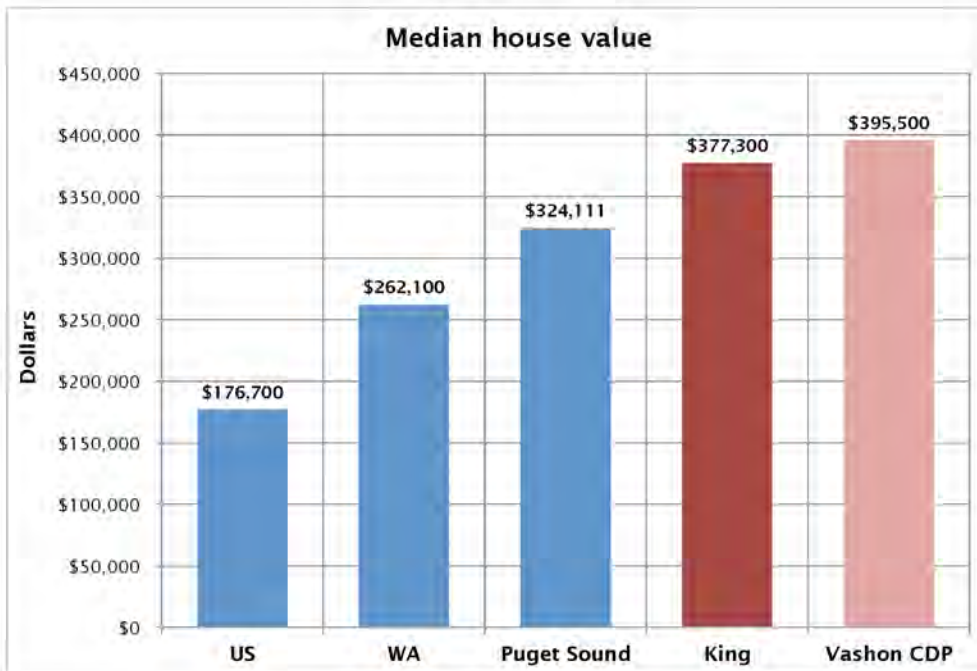
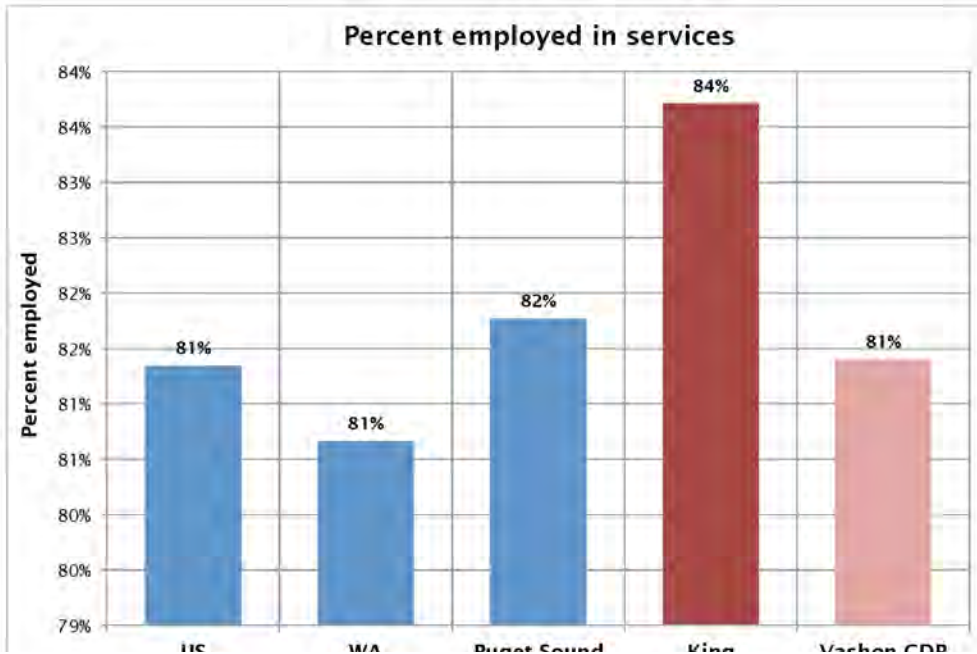
