



CO-SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered into this 18th day of January, 2017, by and between the Vashon Park District, hereinafter called "VPD," and "A Vashon Conversation for the Living About Dying," hereinafter called "Co-Sponsor."

Whereas, VPD owns, maintains, and/or operates certain park, recreational facilities, and equipment on Vashon-Maury Islands, Washington, and the Co-Sponsor wishes to contract with VPD for the right to utilize VPD property for an event without fee per Policy #12-01 "Program Co-Sponsorship" or support for community partnership promotion.

In consideration of the promises, terms, and conditions set forth below, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The program or event meets the guidelines of VPD's mission statement and the conditions prescribed by Policy #12-01 "Program Co-Sponsorship."
2. The event is entitled "A Vashon Conversation for the Living About Dying" and is open to the public without discrimination regarding fee. The event shall be held on March 3 – 5, 2017.
3. VPD equipment used for the event: North end Community Bulletin Board, provided space is available. Co-Sponsor is responsible for scheduling and determining the message within the CBB guidelines.
4. Co-Sponsor agrees to feature VPD's logo in all promotional materials surrounding the event.
5. This Agreement may not be assigned or otherwise transferred by either party hereto.
6. No change, alteration, modification, or addition to this Agreement will be effective unless it is in writing and properly signed by both parties.
7. Indemnification. Co-Sponsor will indemnify, defend, and hold harmless VPD, its agents, employees, and volunteers, from and against any and all liability arising from injury or death to persons or damage to property at Co-Sponsor event resulting in whole or in part from acts, errors, omissions, or negligent acts of Co-Sponsor, its agents, servants, officers, or employees, irrespective of whether in connection with such act or omission it is alleged or claimed that an act of VPD, or its agencies, or employees caused or contributed to the alleged injury or damage. In the event that VPD elects to defend itself against any claim or suit arising from any injury, death, or damage, Co-Sponsor, in addition to providing indemnification and holding VPD harmless as set forth above, shall indemnify VPD for all expenses incurred by VPD in defending such claim or suit, including attorney fees; provided, however, that if (and only if) the provisions of RCW 4.24.115 apply to the work and services under this Agreement and any such damages and injuries to persons or property are caused by or result from the concurrent negligence of VPD, its employees, agents, or representatives, the

Indemnification applies only to the extent of the negligence of the Co-Sponsor, its employees, agents, or representatives.

What Is It?

What Types of Events Are Being Planned?

There will be a broad range of creative, interactive, engaging offerings. Here are just a few:

- A "Before I Die Wall" where we can publicly see one another's hopes and wishes
- Work in a range of mediums by local artists focused on the full life cycle -- from birth to death
- Music and Poetry to Die For
- Discussions of fiction and non-fiction books appealing to readers of all ages
- Folk tales for children about death and loss
- Story-telling and sharing around mortality
- Guest speakers and panels covering spiritual, physical and medical topics
- Guided tour of the cemetery and Green Burial options
- Death Over Dinner Conversations
- Community Remembrance and Story Sharing Celebration -- tribute to all our loved ones who have died
- Resources for advance care planning and completing advance directives
- Documentaries and movies exploring death from personal and cross-cultural perspectives
- Conversations in faith communities focused on end-of-life beliefs, values, wishes
- Island caregiving resources at the end-of-life

The schedule will be open, allowing everyone to explore what they feel curious about. Presentations, workshops and films will be free. We hope residents will find useful and interesting information about death and dying that will help them and their families shift the way they look at death.

Policy:

All organizations requesting program or event Co-sponsorship must meet the listed qualifications and complete a contract for Co-sponsorship with Vashon Park District. This contract will clarify the roles and responsibilities as they relate to the programs' insurance, management, and fiscal responsibilities. Where applicable, the contract shall be reviewed annually by the Executive Director.

Procedures:

- The program or event meets the guidelines of Vashon Park District's Mission Statement.
- The program or event must be open to the public, and no one will be denied for lack of funds.
- The program or event is acceptable to Vashon Park District's insurance carrier (case by case evaluation).
- The program or event would be challenging without participation of both Vashon Park District and co-sponsoring organization.
- Funding or management of program or event would be prohibitive without participation of both Vashon Park District and co-sponsoring organization.
- Conformance with the qualifications and co-sponsorship acceptance is determined by Vashon Park District Executive Director. The Board of Commissioners shall be informed prior to the event.

Applicability:

Organizations, programs, or events which meet the above criteria.
