



2. Consider and take action regarding the minutes from the Board of Directors' October 8, 2018 meeting.
3. Consider and take action regarding Bookkeepers Report and Payment of Bills and Invoices.
4. Consider and take action regarding Operation and Service Matters:
 - a. Receive Manager's Report Regarding Water Service Operations;
 - b. Authorize Write-Off of Delinquent Customers Accounts and/or Authorize Referral of Delinquent Sums to Collections Contractor; and
 - c. Consider, take action, and approve Water System Repairs, Maintenance, and Improvement Projects;
 - d. Discussion and possible action regarding Water Quality Testing and Compliance Matters; and
 - e. Discussion and possible action regarding conversion of utility billing software to Continental Utility Solutions, Inc., including consideration of related vendor agreements for customer bill payments and transaction services.
 - f. Discussion and possible action regarding the current status of fluoridation of the District water supply.
5. Consider and take action regarding Engineering and Construction Matters:
 - a. Receive Engineer's Report Regarding pending engineering projects:
 - i. City of Austin Site Plan Revision for Water Treatment Plant Site;
 - ii. Potential Establishment of Emergency Water Supply Interconnect; and
 - iii. Upgrade in electric service at raw water intake facility and other District facilities.
