

## Reading Log Grade Sheet

Reading logs must be kept in a folder with brads.

The reading logs must be fastened in the brads!

Keep ALL reading logs for the quarter in the brads until the end of the quarter, then they will be moved to your LA binder.



THESE ARE COUNTED AS A READING GRADE.

Students are required to write 4 entries each week. Each entry is worth 25 points.

Students will earn up to 5 extra credit points for an additional entry. An extra point can also be earned by reading 45 minutes or more on each entry. This totals to 10 extra points.

**Title** – Must be written out the first time it is used. Total value- 10 points

**Pages read** – This can either be the number of pages read, or beginning and ending page numbers. Total value- 5 points

**Time spent reading** – Must be a minimum of 20 minutes. Total value- 5 points  
+ Reading for more than 45 minutes is one extra credit point

**Date** – Date must be written. Total value- 5 points.

THESE ARE COUNTED AS ENGLISH.

**Summary-** Two separate summaries must accompany the entries. This side of the reading log will count for a grammar grade. Each summary is worth 50 points and must include the following:

5-7 sentences (minus 10 points for any missing sentences)

Must be legible

Must make sense

Must be written in complete sentences, with correct grammar (spelling, capitalization, punctuation)

All sentences are written in past tense. You read the story in the past, the events happened in the past. You retell in the past tense.

++ An additional 10 points can be earned if turned in two days early (Wednesday), or 5 points if one day early (Thursday).
