

**OLG COVID Report: Updated 3/25/21 7:00am**  
COVID Handbook Updates will be highlighted in Yellow in

Yesterday evening, Wednesday, March 24th , OLG had a positive COVID case on campus in the Main School Office. The COVID Task Force Team has been made aware and has approved all our preliminary guidelines for handling the situation. Fortunately, because it was not in a classroom, **no student quarantines are needed** based on exposure time guidelines. However, I will need to be in quarantine for the next 14 days per our protocols. I will be getting tested today just to provide more information which I will share with our families, but regardless of the results, I am still in quarantine through Easter and will be working from home.

Dr. Weaver has been fully vaccinated and thus will be manning the school office the rest of this week. The faculty has been informed and are also stepping up to help out as needed. Also, because the school is fogged every evening, the COVID team has not required any additional cleaning protocols that would delay us from opening the school today.

We are still working on a long range plan for coverage of the school office and are working with the COVID Task Force Team to ensure all safety protocols are in full force at our school. As this is our first on campus incident with COVID, we will update you as we move forward and the COVID Task Force Team will also be sending you information so we can be as transparent as possible.
