8:30am-12:00pm and 1:00-3:00pm.

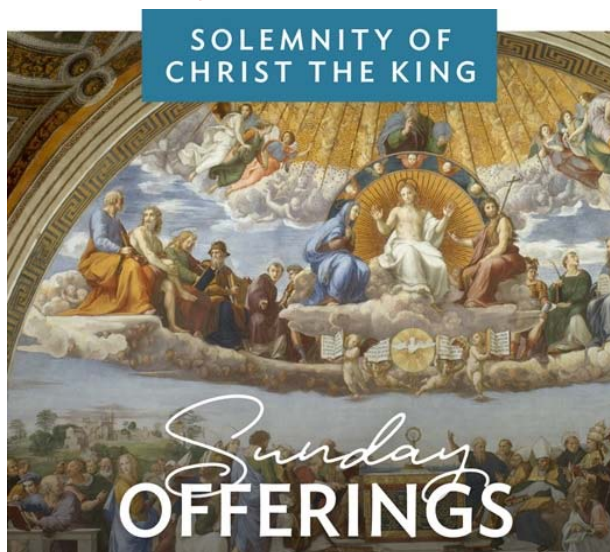

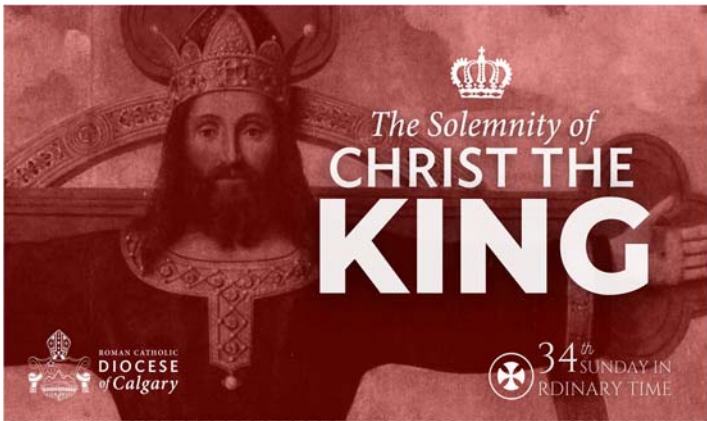

**First Sunday of Advent is on Sunday, November 28th.**

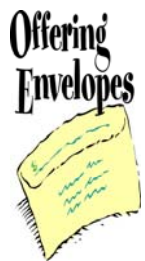
### 2022 Donation Envelopes are now ready for pick-up at the Parish Office!

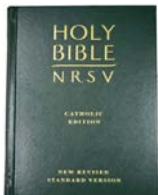

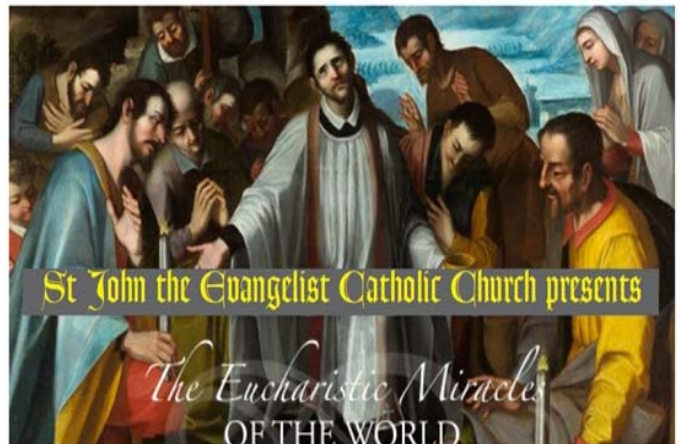
Pastoral Care is the unconditional caring response to the sick, homebound, lonely, dying and bereaved.
