Our Confirmation Program offers catechesis, prayer, scripture, reflection, community building, ministry opportunities, service to others, personal sharing, and retreats. We strive to help the Confirmation candidate understand that faith development and participation in the Holy Catholic Church is a lifelong journey.

This sacrament, which provides the fullness of the gifts of the Holy Spirit, is of great spiritual assistance to our youth during this time in their lives.

Requirements:

- Family must be registered & participating parishioners of Epiphany of the Lord Catholic Community.
- Student should be attending Sunday Mass weekly.
- Student must be a **Junior or Senior** in High School.
- Student must be at least 16 years old.
- Student must have been registered and actively participated in a formal faith formation program or be enrolled at a Catholic School at least one year prior to the immediate sacrament preparation year. Student should be registered and enrolled in Catholic School or Faith Formation during the Sacramental Preparation Year as well.
- Student must be well catechized in the Catholic Faith and exhibit an active spiritual life.
- Student must attend two retreats during the Immediate Preparation year:
- **Day Retreat at Epiphany: Sunday, September 20, 2020 2:00 p.m. - 8:15 p.m.**
 - Students will attend 5:30 p.m. Mass
- **Weekend Retreat at Stoney Creek Ranch January 15-17, 2021.**
- A Catholic parent must attend one of the Confirmation Parent Sacrament Meetings in the fall to begin the preparation process (see dates above).
- Registration is required (one form for each student).
- Registration is not complete without a photocopy of the student's Baptism certificate.
 - Students who do not have a baptismal certificate turned in by September 20, 2020 will not be able to attend class.
