BIMONTHLY HEALING MASS: July 17th, at St. Joseph Cathedral, A Mass of Healing and Healing Service will be celebrated on Monday, July 17, 6:30 p.m., at St. Joseph Cathedral, 212 E. Broad Street, Columbus. Following the Mass, a Service of Healing will begin with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Veneration of Relic of the True Cross of Christ, followed by an opportunity for each person to speak individually with a priest and receive prayers of healing for what they seek; the Sacrament of Anointing of Sick will also be available. The Service of Healing will close with Benediction. All infirmities (e.g., cancer and other debilitating diseases and conditions), in addition to those who seek emotional and spiritual healing. All caregivers, family members, and members of the medical community are invited as well. Parking is available at the rear of the Cathedral accessible off East Gay Street. Handicap-accessible elevator is located in the courtyard (west side of the Cathedral) on East Broad Street.
