**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:**

The Feast of the **Baptism of the Lord** today ends the liturgical Christmas Season. Let us take a few moments after Mass to thank Jesus for the gift of our own Baptism which forgives sins and makes us sons and daughters of our heavenly Father. We also remember in prayer all those in our RCIA program who eagerly await their own Baptism at the Easter Vigil.

**We will no longer take up a second collection except on 5th Sundays for the St. Vincent de Paul Society support.**

This mostly applies to St. Rose which takes up a number of second collections. Continue to use your envelopes provided for such things as school support, flowers, church beautification, etc., but they will all be taken up in the main offertory and recorded accordingly. There may be occasional times when we'll need a second collection. These may be for disaster relief called for by the Bishops or for a missionary co-op appeal, but these will be announced in advance. Thank you for your continued generosity in the main offertory each weekend.

Finally, I hope to clarify Deacon Mark's role in our consortium. He is still our deacon assigned to assist me in ministry to these wonderful parishes. This has not changed, and you'll see him serving at the altar on the weekends as much as he has in the past. What has changed is his full-time employment in the consortium. This was a budget decision that was difficult, but had to be made to help with our bottom line. It has not solved our financial difficulties, but the savings helps. Our beloved homebound will still be visited regularly by me, Fr. Daniel and our dedicated parishioners who already bring Communion to them. Deacon Mark did a wonderful job in these past 5 years in making sure our sick and homebound parishioners were spiritually cared for. He also helped me a great deal in getting settled here these past 6 months. I'm grateful for Deacon Mark's continued dedication to our parishes. If you are interested in bring Communion to the homebound on the weekends, please call the consortium office.
