FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

Congratulations to **Mykala Vann**, who received her First Communion and Confirmation from Bishop Campbell on Friday, March 22 at Christ the King Church. Mykayla is part of our RCIA program, and we are thrilled that she was able to receive her sacraments with many other baptized Catholics in Columbus. We continue to pray for those Catechumens and Candidates who look forward to receive their sacraments at Easter.

Bishop Robert J. Brennan will be installed as the 12th Bishop of Columbus on Friday, March 29th. In order to mark and celebrate this historic event, Bishop Campbell has lifted the obligation for Catholics to abstain from meat on that Friday. The priests were sent the following message from the Chancery: **"Bishop Campbell has issued a decree granting all Catholics of the Diocese of Columbus a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat on Friday, March 29, 2019, in honor of the very significant and historic occasion of the Installation of the Most Rev. Robert J. Brennan as 12th Bishop of Columbus."** So, this doesn't mean you *MUST* eat meat on Friday, but you are able to if you choose. :) Please still consider the solemn nature of a Friday in the season of Lent, and think of some way to observe it by participating in the Stations of the Cross or some other penance. We joyfully welcome Bishop Brennan as our new shepherd!

Remember that we have our **Consortium Penance Service at 7:00 on Monday, March 25 at St. Rose**. With many outside confessors, this is an excellent opportunity to encounter Jesus' mercy in the Sacrament of Confession in preparation for Easter.

March 25th is also the **Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord**. This feast celebrates the event when the archangel Gabriel announced to Mary that she would be the Mother of God. She then conceived Jesus in her womb by the power of the Holy Spirit. Let us consider how we can be more attentive to Pro-Life issues and causes as we meditate on the Annunciation. Also, it's only 9 months until Christmas!

Brennan, auxiliary bishop of the Diocese of Rockville Centre, New York as the 12th Bishop of Columbus will take place at 2:00 p.m. Friday, March 29th at St. Joseph Cathedral 212 E. Broad Street. It will be followed by a public reception in the Walter Commons at Columbus St. Charles Preparatory School, 2010 E. Broad St. Bishop Brennan also will take part in a Solemn evening Vespers service at the cathedral at 7:00 p.m. Thursday, March 28th, to be followed by a reception in the cathedral undercroft. Because of limited space in the cathedral, seating for the installation and Vespers service will be by ticket only.
