Business Reports:

Vicariate:

Parish Finance Council: Our cash amount is down by \$18,000 indicative of the lack of church attendance. Last week, 10-11-20, was the first Sunday we attained our goal with donations of \$9,098. October meeting was not held yet.

STANDING REPORTS:

OLD BUSINESS:

Day of Evangelization: Fr. Patrick relayed that Encounter Ministries, which trains and equips Catholics on how to evangelize, will be here on Saturday, October 24 for our Parish Day of Evangelization. Beginning at 11:00 for orientation, 12:00 prayer, 12:05-3:10, evangelizing in the neighborhoods, 3:00 sandwiches for all those evangelizing, 4:00 Mass. The orientation and prayer will be livestreamed from church. All are encouraged to pray for the success of this day joining us in church from 12:00-3:00 or at home.

Fr. Patrick also discussed the Alpha Formation Program, the Healing Service at CC at 6:30 p.m. on Nov. 7th, and Trunk or Treat on October 31st.

Families of Parishes: Fr. Patrick attended the Sept. 29th meeting of parish priests. Two possible Family configurations were discussed:

- A. St. Charles Lawanga, St. Moses the Great, Christ the King, Gesu, St. Peter Claver, and St. Suzanne/Our Lady Gate of Heaven.
- B. Corpus Christ, St. Scholastica, Sts. Peter and Paul, St. Mary of Redford, St. Juan Diego, Presentation/ Our Lady of Victory.

There may possibly be a third option.
The next meeting is to be held on October 20th.

NEW BUSINESS:

Technology & Ring Central: We need to try to secure a corporate rate for our ZOOM meetings.

Leadership Team Update: There are seven members on the team. They are trying to restructure and standardize the meetings and minutes of various committees to simplify and align them. A unified format will be sent to Parish Council for the reporting from each committee. Also, a new format for requesting monies from the leadership team will be developed.

The leadership team also wants to focus on how we will get back to how we once were, understanding how it will have to BE DIFFERENT.

Faith Formation:

We were supposed to have 15 communion and reconciliation candidates this year but as of today only three applicants have followed through. Follow-up calls to be made.

Generations of Faith: First session had 114 who viewed the video. The Session Two topic will be on "The History of Salvation".

Stewardship:

Our Endowment Fund--Donations may be given in smaller increments to build up to a larger amount eventually adding a leaf to the giving tree.

Carolyn Wilson will meet with Catholic Foundation on October 20th for a Webinar.

Worship Committee:

Liturgy planners will speak first during the opening portion of the next meeting.

A meeting was held on Saturday 10-11 to plan for the Advent Season.

Hospitality: C. Lawrence... No new meetings have been scheduled. Nothing new to report.

Faith Formation: E. O'Neill... There are six new candidates for Confirmation.

Stewardship: A. Glinz... CSA has a current shortfall of \$30,000.
