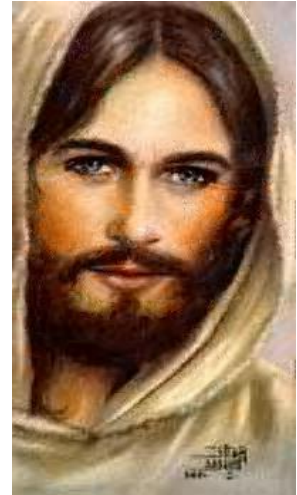

## **A Covenant with St. Susanna Parish**

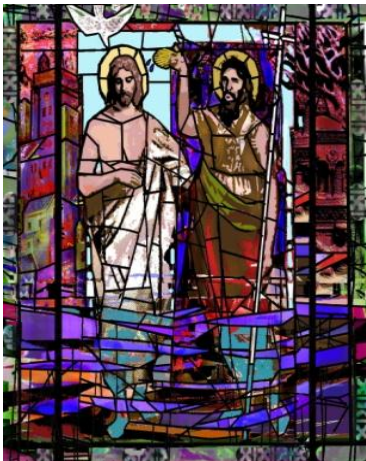

- They pray daily

- They serve in ministering to God's people in one of many opportunities available throughout the year
- They tithe their treasure to an amount determined through prayer
