RETURN TO CAMPUS GRADES K – 6TH:

As you know our waiver and plan was submitted to the county on September 2, 2020 for grades K-6. The state and county are not accepting waivers for grades 7-8 at this time however as soon as we are able to allow these grades on campus we will. These two grades will continue with remote learning. We want to commend these students and families as the students have done an amazing job continuing their learning under the guidance of their teachers and parents.

The plans for grades K-6 were then submitted to the state and we have been approved to open with in person instruction! We are very excited about the opportunity to have students back on campus for instruction following the safety protocol outlined in the plan which was shared with you and again can be found on our website. To give you time to transition from remote learning to in person instruction, we will be starting in person instruction the week of September 21st.

We plan to open on Monday, September 21 with grades K-3 with a minimum day, noon release. Starting Tuesday, September 22 grades K-6 will be on campus with another minimum day. Wednesday, September 23 will also be a minimum day for grades K-6. We want to ensure students are comfortable with the transition back to school and are able to follow the new procedures and protocols. These half days will have instruction but will also be critical for us to have students well prepared in the classroom. On Thursday and Friday we will have a full day with a 2:00 release. We are ending the school day at 2:00 to help ease the transition from remote learning to in person instruction and this will be release time moving forward for the time being.

At this time we will not be able to provide extended care due to mixing of cohorts. A survey will be sent in the next few weeks seeking who has a need for extended care. Extended care will be only available for sign up on a weekly basis and not on a daily basis. Once we are able to provide this as a safe option it will be held in the parish hall in the weeks to come.

important to have a successful opening to in person instruction. We are so excited to see you and your family on September 21st for a return to campus. Again, if your family chooses to stay in remote learning option the teachers will be providing you with the needed information about their daily schedules.
