Included in the presentation will be the concepts of extraordinary/ ordinary, double effect and assisted nutrition and hydration in a format based upon hospital/medical experiences and not mere dry teaching. It will be based on his background in obtaining Certification in Catholic Healthcare from the National Catholic Bioethics Center and my experience with the Lodi Memorial Hospital Bioethics Committee.
