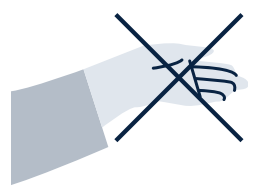
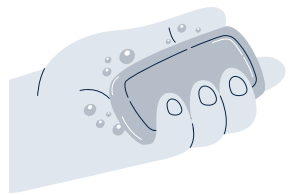


Keep Our Workplace Safe!

Groups will be required to clean up and **sanitize** tables, chairs, common **touch spots** like light switches and door knobs before leaving the area.

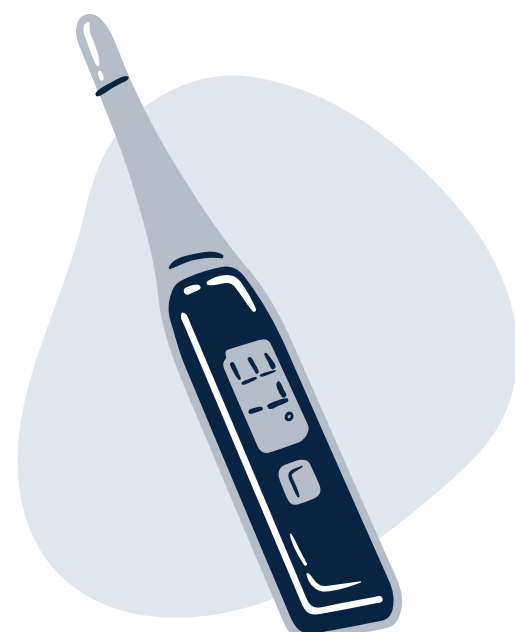
When using the restroom, please spray the touch points with the spray bottle in the restroom.

Guidelines for groups using any space at Church of the Blessed Sacrament

We Ask Our Guests To:

- Allow social distance of at least six feet from others while in the facility and we recommend that you wear a mask.
- Wash hands frequently and for 20 seconds after using the restroom. Please use the spray bottle to spray over the faucet, toilet, and stall handles before you leave the restroom.
- Utilize hand sanitizer dispensers throughout the church.
- Please do not visit our facility if ill.
- Groups will be required to clean up tables, chairs and common touch spots like light switches and door knobs before leaving the area. (We suggest that each person in the meeting clean up their own area).
- Use the Victory sprayer located in St. Martha's kitchen (towards the back refrigerators) and follow instructions for use. Spray over any surfaces your group may have used. Remember to place the battery on prior to use and place on the charger after use.
- Food and Beverages will only be allowed in Hardebeck Hall during a staff sponsored/ hosted event or with prior approval from the parish office. Food must be plated or prepackaged, no buffet style. Masks are required in the kitchen and we ask that you maintain 6' of distance between one another. Participants are responsible for cleaning after each event.
- Notify us of confirmed cases of COVID-19 if you have been at the Church of the Blessed Sacrament.
