Dear Westerly Local Businesses,

On December 19, 2018, the town of Westerly lost an amazing man, father, relative, and friend that belonged to our community. His name was Angelo Turano, 53 years old. His death was caused by a tragic accident, leaving his family and the entire town of Westerly in devastation and heartbreak.

He leaves behind his beloved wife Grace Turano and his 3 children, Angelo Jr., 19 years old, Adriana, 18 years old, and Jonathon, 14 years old. Along with his mother Giuseppina, 3 sisters, brother in laws, nieces, nephews, relatives, and many friends.

He worked for the town of Westerly for 22 years as a senior mechanic, and also plowed our roads during all of our snow storms ensuring our towns safety.

He was everyones friend! He was always there to give you a hand whenever you needed one and would go out of his way to make time for everyone. He loved to have a conversation with you, or would just stop to say hello to you. He always made sure to get a smile out of you, even if you were having a bad day. Many believe he was an angel while he was here with us all.

On his spare time he was a coach for our rec leagues, such as basketball or soccer. One way or another you would see Angelo supporting youth sports on the side line or as a spectator cheering on his team or his very own children as they played sports.

His number one priority were his children and his wife. His time with his family was precious and made sure they were taken care of at all times. He loved to spend time with them. They had many laughs together, go on family vacations, watch movies together, he would play in the yard with them, and the list can go on and on. Quality time was precious to his family. Their time was cut short. Words can't describe the pain, the loss, the emptiness and the mourning that is still left with them today.

With Angelo being the main financial supporter for the family, his number one priority was to take care of his family. Unfortunately, immediately after his death, on December 31, 2018 their Health Insurance was terminated. Temporarily the family is on Cobra. His older son Angelo Jr. is currently in his first year of college. His daughter Adriana will be graduating from High School this year and starting college by September. There will be many challenges for the family, financially.

Today, we are asking for donations for a fundraiser in the memory of Angelo. A few family and friends of the Turano family will be hosting this fundraiser to help with the financial burdens that this tragic death left behind for his family. This fundraiser will help Angelo's family by giving them some security and cushion to help them with finances. All proceeds will go to the Turano Family.

The Fundraiser will take place on Wednesday, May 8 2019 at 5:30 PM, located at the Westerly Yacht Club. There will be food, raffles, and cocktails. Tickets are also available to purchase for \$30.
