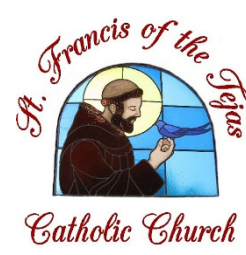

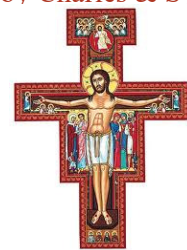

Forward March of the Kingdom

A large crowd on the move is an ambiguous phenomenon. Its collective energy can be mobilized for good or for evil. A 1965 march from Selma to Montgomery helped dramatize the struggle for African American civil rights. By contrast, Mussolini's 1922 March on Rome led to the triumph of Italian fascism.

One wonders about the mood of the crowd that followed Jesus out of Jericho. Were they expecting a triumphant "March on Jerusalem" that would restore the greatness of Israel? Bartimaeus calls Jesus "Son of David," suggesting that he, too, may be caught up in such messianic dreams.

Once a crowd gets moving, it develops an intoxicating momentum. Those who rebuke Bartimaeus and demand that he be silent have clearly drunk deeply. What weight do the needs of a solitary beggar have when placed in the balance with the glory awaiting in Jerusalem? Nothing must be allowed to stop the forward march of history.

But Jesus stops. He hears a single cry for help, and for that he stops the great machine that has formed itself around him. No doubt they were surprised. The kingdoms of this world always leave their version of Bartimaeus by the side of the road, just "acceptable losses" and "collateral damage." Not so in the kingdom that Jesus preaches. In his kingdom, even a blind panhandler has infinite worth. This, ultimately, is what Bartimaeus comes to see and what the crowd comes to see. And so must we, if we are to "follow Jesus on the way." Marcha Adelante del Reino

Una gran multitud en movimiento es una ambigua fenómeno. Su energía colectiva puede movilizarse para bien o para mal. Una marcha de 1965 de Selma a Montgomery ayudó a dramatizar la lucha por Derechos civiles afroamericanos. Por el contrario, la marcha de Mussolini sobre Roma en 1922 condujo al triunfo del fascismo italiano.

Uno se pregunta sobre el estado de ánimo de la multitud que siguió a Jesús fuera de Jericó. ¿Esperaban una "Marcha sobre Jerusalén" triunfante que restauraría la grandeza de Israel? Bartimeo llama a Jesús "Hijo de David", lo que sugiere que él también puede verse atrapado en esos sueños mesiánicos.

Una vez que una multitud se mueve, desarrolla una impulso embriagador. Los que reprenden Bartimeo y exigirle que se calle claramente han bebido profundamente. ¿Qué peso tienen las necesidades de un mendigo solitario cuando se pone en equilibrio con el gloria aguardando en Jerusalén? Nada debe ser permitido detener el avance de la historia.

Pero Jesús se detiene. Oye un solo grito de ayuda, y para eso detiene la gran máquina que se ha formado a su alrededor. Sin duda se sorprendieron. Los reinos de este mundo siempre dejan su versión de Bartimeo al costado del camino, solo "pérdidas aceptables" y "daños colaterales". No es así en el reino que Jesús predica. En su reino, incluso un mendigo ciego tiene un valor infinito. Esto, en última instancia, es lo que Bartimeo viene a ver y la multitud viene a ver. Y nosotros también debemos, si vamos a "seguir a Jesús en el camino". J. Peter Nixon
