*Oh my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to heaven, and especially those who are in most need of your mercy.*

(after each "Hail Mary," you can add the appropriate proclamation:  
<different in each of the five secrets>.)

Please: Keep and increase our faith in Your Immaculate Conception!

Please: Keep and increase faith in us into your unbroken virginity!

Please: Keep and increase faith in Your true dignity in us Mother of God!

Please: Keep and increase our honor and love for your images!

Please: May the fire of your love and perfect love shine in our hearts in devotion to you!

**MEDITATION**

The next element of this prayer is to consider one or more rosary mysteries for at least 15 minutes. Mary said that this kind of prayer was keeping her company. As a help in meditating, you can carefully read a corresponding passage of the Bible or book, listen to a prayer recording or homily. This consideration should also be accompanied by a worthwhile intention.

**Why the Five First Saturdays of the Month?**

During one of the visits, when Sr. Lucy asked Jesus: why the service should take place on five First Saturdays? She heard that it was because of five kinds of insults and blasphemy against the Immaculate Heart of Mary:

1. Blasphemy against the Immaculate Conception.
2. Against the virginity of the Mother of God.
3. Against her divine motherhood, at the same time opposing recognition of her as the Mother of mankind.
4. The acts of those who attempt to publicly instill indifference into the hearts of children, contempt and even hatred of the Immaculate Mother.
5. The acts of those who profane the images of the Holy Virgin.

**FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME**  
**JULY 5th, 2020 YEAR A**

**\* REFLECTION \***

In the Collect, we pray that we will be eternally blessed, freed from the bondage of sin. How to achieve happiness? Whose life can be called happy? How do you get a "piece of paradise on earth"? We climb to the top and this means that you have to clench your teeth, be persistent and willing to sacrifice. An individual in a fulfilled and happy life could be called like our God, who, like the Father, cares about the happiness of his children. "He sent his Son to let us have life and have it in abundance". Looking at Jesus, we can see his beautiful, fulfilled human life. What is the secret of happiness that God wants to lead us to? How to achieve it? Let's consider what the Liturgy of the Word tells us.

Today we heard the announcement of the arrival of the humble King, the Messiah. "Behold, your King is coming to you ...". This solemn invitation is a call to Rejoice! A call for joy! – and to bring this atmosphere to liturgical celebrations. *Shouts of joy are to accompany the entrance of the King, the Messiah, into our hearts.*

Zachariah's vision takes us into a new Messianic era in which, as God's People, we see God's return to human hearts. The expected King arrives like an ordinary traveler, on a donkey. His coming is peaceful. The Humble Wanderer King, someone who learned humility in the hard school of life; The Messiah King has the strength to destroy chariots and horses, destroy weapons. His Kingdom will unite all peoples. The crowd greeted Jesus as the Son of David, as King of Israel, the expected Messiah. The Risen One's gift to the disciples was PEACE; Jesus describes himself as **"meek and humble of heart."** All the Lord's poor find shelter in this Heart. A happy life is a life of peace coming from a humble King.

The more happiness we want, the stronger we need union with Christ to live by the power of His Spirit. The right antiphon for Holy Communion encourages us:

**"Taste and see that the Lord is good, blessed the man who seeks refuge in him."**

## Z ŻYCIA PARAFII I KOŚCIOŁA

1. Bóg okazuje nam miłosierdzie. Przystał nam swojego Syna, Który zło-żył w ofierze swoje człowieczeństwo, aby nam otworzyć drogę z niewoli grzechu. On pragnie, abyśmy krocząc drogą nam wskazaną osiągnęli wieczne szczęście. Echo proroczej zapowiedzi Zachariasza słyszymy w za-proszeniu Jezusa skierowanym do utrudzonych i obciążonych. Jezus ci-chością i pokorą serca przyciąga do siebie ludzi. Tym, którzy Go przyjmu-ją oznajmia tajemnice Królestwa, które są zakryte przed wielkimi i rozro-pnymi.

### CZEŚĆ RÓŻAŃCA ŚWIĘTEGO

Należy odmówić pięć tajemnic w intencji wynagradzającej. Można rozwa-zać którąkolwiek z części różańca. Po każdym dziesiątku należy odmówić modlitwę: *O mój Jezu, przebacz nam nasze grzechy, zachowaj nas od ognia piekielnego, zaprowadź wszystkie dusze do nieba i pomóż szczegól-nie tym, którzy najbardziej potrzebują Twojego miłosierdzia.* (po każdym „Zdrowaś Maryjo” można dodać odpowiednie wezwanie *<inne w każdej z pięciu tajemnic>*.)

Prosimy: Zachowaj i pomnażaj w nas wiarę w Twoje Niepokalane Poczęcie!

Prosimy: Zachowaj i pomnażaj w nas wiarę w Twoje nieprzerwane Dziewictwo!

Prosimy: Zachowaj i pomnażaj w nas wiarę w Twoją rzeczywistą godność Matki Bożej!

Prosimy: Zachowaj i pomnażaj w nas cześć i miłość do Twoich wizerunków!

Prosimy: Rozpromień we wszystkich sercach żar miłości i doskonałego Nabożeństwa do Ciebie!

### ROZWAŻANIE

Następnym elementem tego nabożeństwa jest rozważanie jednej lub kilku tajemnic różańcowych w ciągu przynajmniej 15 minut. O tym rodzaju modlitwy Maryja powiedziała, że jest **dotrzymywaniem Jej towarzystwa** Jako pomoc w rozmyślaniu można uważnie przeczytać odpowiadający danej tajemnicy fragment Pisma Świętego lub książki, wysłuchać konfe-rencji lub homilii. Temu rozważaniu także powinna towarzyszyć intencja wynagradzająca.

### Dlaczego Pięć Pierwszych Sobót Miesiąca?

Podczas jednego z widzeń, kiedy siostra Łucja zapytała Pana Jezusa: *dlaczego nabożeństwo ma się odbywać akurat w pięć sobót?* Usłyszała, że to ze względu na pięć rodzajów zniewag i bluźnierstw przeciw Niepokala-nemu Sercu Maryi:

1. Bluźnierstwo przeciw Niepokalanemu Poczęciu.
2. Przeciw dziewictwu Matki Bożej.
3. Przeciw Jej boskiemu macierzyństwu, przy równoczesnym sprzeciwie uznania Jej za Matkę rodzaju ludzkiego.
4. Czyny tych, którzy usiłują publicznie wpoić w serca dzieci obojętność, pogardę, a nawet nienawiść do matki Niepokalanej.
5. Czyny tych, którzy profanują wizerunki Majświętszej Panny.

**Bring your own face mask to attend Mass.**

Canadian diocese of Sault Ste. Marie in the province of Ontario announced that it will repair six statues from the Way of the Cross station in the Grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes in Sudbury, which recently destroyed vandals. Some of the sculptures have their heads and arms cut off. No missing items found so far. Stations commemorating the Passion stood in a place that was modeled on the Grotto in Lourdes, where in 1858 Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette, in the early 1950s. The place itself was built in 1907 by a French-speaking community in this region of Canada. Until now it is a place of many pilgrimages and prayers. The figure of Mary here is called "Queen of Gallorum".

Recent vandalism of May 22 this year in Sudbury, as a result of which six figures were damaged, is not associated with the latest wave of incidents during which the monuments are devastated under the slogan of fighting racism. According to local media, no suspects were identified and the investigation was stalled. The diocese has already made contact with artists who can repair damaged figures. The diocese, in order to avoid the enormous costs associated with casting the statues again, would like to encourage sculptors to produce the missing parts of the damaged figures.
