INTRODUCTORY

1. Entrance Antiphon or Hymn
2. Greeting
3. Penitential Act
 1. Act of confession prayer. (I confess to almighty God. . .)
 2. Preparation to celebrate the sacred mysteries. (Lord have mercy/Kyrie, eleison... Grant us your salvation.)
 3. You were sent to heal the contrite of heart: (Lord have Mercy. . .)
 4. Rite for the Blessing & Sprinkling of water.
4. Glory to God (not sung during Advent or Lent)
5. Collect (Let us pray) (Pause for Silent Prayer)
