Please provide an empty bowl, a pitcher of water, a hand towel, and one lemon cut in half for hand washing. The cut lemon should be placed in the empty bowl.

Cotton balls and soap are not needed.

A purificator or hand towel should be brought to the Bishop along with the open bowl of Chrism at the time of anointing.

If the Eucharist is distributed under both forms, the ratio of chalices to ciboria should be two to one.
