Wishing you a wonderful summer! Please find a preview of some 4th Grade concepts.

Religion-We will be learning more about the 10 Commandments, the Beatitudes, and the Virtues.

Math-Focus on addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division of multi-digit numbers up to 9,999, fractions, and geometry. It is imperative that students have multiplication and division facts memorized!

Reading-Expository writing with main ideas, details, conclusions, and generalizations are a big focus in 4th grade reading, so READ, READ, READ this summer.

Social Studies-This curriculum is about Pennsylvania. Stop, look around, and document any historic spots you might see while traveling around the state this summer.

Science-The curriculum includes earth science (rocks, minerals, erosion), physical science (matter, energy, etc.), and life science (plants, animals, and humans).

Please bring the following supplies on the first day of school.

- A pencil case big enough to hold the following:
 - 2 highlighters
 - 12-inch ruler with inches and centimeters (not the bending kind)
 - 2 red pens
 - 2 glue sticks
 - 3-4 sharpened pencils
 - Good, sharp scissors
- A drawstring bag big enough to hold the following:
 - Colored pencils
 - a 12 inch ruler with inches and centimeters (not the bending kind)
 - Crayon/markers (thick or thin) You will also need:
 - an 8 pocket folder (no Trapper Keepers/Binders)
 - 5 marbled, wide ruled, 100 page composition books
 - 2 extra-large book socks
 - Dictionary (that fits in the desk)
 - A box of tissues, and a roll of paper towels
 - A roll of contact paper or brown craft paper to cover workbooks (this should be kept at home)
