A Breakdown of St. Roch Parish's Diocesan Services Appeal

*This weekend there will be a special collection to help defray St. Roch Parish's obligation in the annual Diocesan Services Appeal. The money collected provides the Diocese of Victoria with operating capital for the basic diocesan services, that is, those services that do not come directly from a parish. The 2018 pledge goal established for St. Roch by the diocese is \$27,676.00. The parish has paid in \$8,000 and parishioners thus far have pledged \$3,775.00 making the new balance \$15,901.00. We have a total of 179 registered families in the parish. If each family contributed \$88, it could cover the remaining DSA pledge. In 2017, the parish paid in a total of \$22,218.00. **May the Lord bless you through your generosity!***
