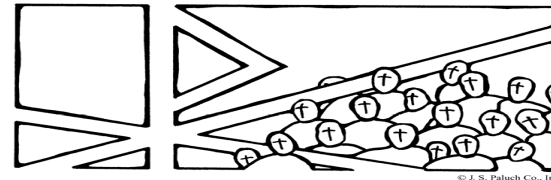
Pro Life Corner....

The Sacrifice of the Mass

It is a longstanding tradition in the Church to request a priest to offer the Mass for a specific intention, even when one cannot be physically present at the Mass. The church considers the Mass as the greatest possible prayer of intercession – as it is the perfect offering of Christ to the Father by making present the paschal mystery of his death and resurrection (EWTN). A Mass may be for the intention of someone living or deceased or for a specific occasion. It is one of the greatest gifts you can give to someone!
