Weekly Reflection ~ July 28 17th Sunday of Ordinary Time

The Our Father is a prayer we say so often that we seldom stop to think about what we are saying. Take some time to say this prayer slowly out loud and reflect on each phrase. You may want to focus on one phrase at a time and take several days to go through the prayer. Notice what is asked for in the prayer: what is needed for today, forgiveness as we forgive others, and avoiding temptation. Reflect on what you need for the day. Consider how you have forgiven someone who has offended you—is this how you want to be forgiven? What are the temptations in your life? Do you take any active steps to avoid them?
