SEPTUAGESIMA SUNDAY

The season of Lent begins in about two and a half weeks. With the reception of ashes on Ash Wednesday, the members of the Church enter more deeply, in a liturgical way, into our Lord's redemptive mission of his Cross and Resurrection. This prepares the Church for the great renewal of the promises of Baptism on Easter.

In her Divine Wisdom, guided by the Holy Ghost, Holy Mother Church centuries ago introduced a pre-Lent mini-season of Septuagesima. In the official Latin text missals (of both forms of the Mass), the season preparing for Easter is labeled Quadragesima, which means "fortieth day," as in the 40th day before Easter. In English, we label the season as Lent, from an old English word meaning 'spring.' So, to help Catholics begin to slow down and prepare for the beginning of Lent, the three Sundays preceding Ash Wednesday are called Quinquagesima, Sexagesima, and Septuagesima. Although not literally the 50th, 60th, and 70th days before Easter, the names do provide a backing up from Quadragesima, the 40th day, so that Ash Wednesday and the beginning of Lent is not so abrupt.

Today, in the traditional liturgy, the Alleluia and the Sunday Gloria are removed until Easter. Today, purple vestments are introduced. As the *Roman Catholic Daily Missal 1962* says in its introduction to Septuagesima, "During the period from Septuagesima to Ash Wednesday, the liturgy speaks no more of our greatness but contemplates the misery of fallen humanity, the fatal consequences of original sin and actual sin, and the sacrifice that God asked from the faithful Melchisedech, symbol of the sacrifice that Jesus brings for the whole of humanity."

As Lent 2020 draws near, it is time to prepare for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that assists us in facing, as sinners, our dire need for the saving mission of our Lord Jesus Christ. What will you be prepared to do to respond our Lord's invitation to enter more deeply into His Divine Mystery this coming Lent?
