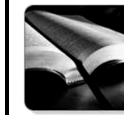

***Weekly Reflection ~ March 15***  
***Third Sunday of Lent***

*There have always been serious divisions between the various religions of the world. Each group holding fast to their beliefs and firmly declaring that anyone who does not believe as they do is wrong or even evil. In Jesus' day, the Samaritans were a good despised sect and no righteous Jew would have anything to do with them, much less a woman with a bad reputation. Yet Jesus takes time to talk with the Samaritan woman at the well. He does not condemn her. He does not put her down in any way. On the contrary, he treats her with respect and kindness and even tells her that he is the Messiah (something he doesn't normally proclaim to anyone.) Consider how you treat those who do not hold your beliefs - do you follow the example Jesus have given us?*
