Weekly Reflection ~ April 26 Third Sunday in Easter

In a time when our country is so passionately divided that people are prone to dismissing the views of others as ignorant or even evil. The disciples' journey to Emmaus may have a message for us today. When the "stranger" joins them they are appalled that he does not know what has been going on but they do not turn away from him. They explain their views of recent events and, perhaps more importantly, they listen to what the stranger has to say. Because of their openness, they see things in a new light. How open are you to listening to the views of others and considering their opinions? Can you step back from the rhetoric that makes objective discussion impossible? Are you willing to take a look at the facts or do you just rely on your feelings?
