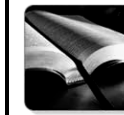

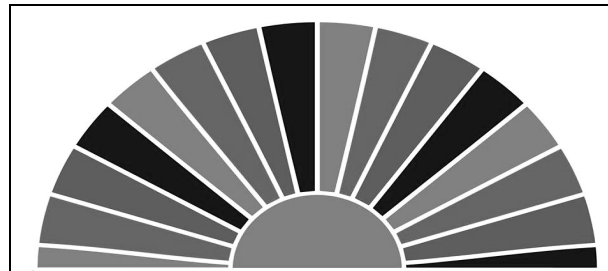
One Million Rosaries for Unborn Babies
