Heavenly Father, bestow Your abundant blessings on all Deacons, their families, their ministry and service.


Grant that they may be filled with grace and power as they work among the people.

The Sacrifice of the Mass

It is a longstanding tradition in the Church to request a priest to offer the Mass for a specific intention, even when one cannot be physically present at the Mass. The church considers the Mass as the greatest possible prayer of intercession – as it is the perfect offering of Christ to the Father by making present the paschal mystery of his death and resurrection (EWTN). A Mass may be for the intention of someone living or deceased or for a specific occasion. It is one of the greatest gifts you can give to someone!
