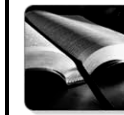

Weekly Reflection ~ September 13 24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

The passage from Sirach gives us a clear guide to how we should conduct our relationships. We are told to forgive injustices, refrain from nursing our anger, and treat others with mercy. These are not things that come easy to us. We want wrongs punished and we long for revenge. If we would be disciples of Christ, we must learn to forgive and granted mercy from our Lord. Consider those things that nurse your anger and your resentment and pray for the grace to let go of those feelings. "Forgive your neighbor's injustice; then when you pray, your own sins will be forgiven."
