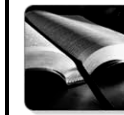

**Weekly Reflection ~ September 26
25th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Our human nature finds it very difficult to accept God's way of doing things as "just." Many of Jesus' parables tell us that God does not judge things the way we would. God knows our hearts and understands our struggles in a way that even we don't understand ourselves, much less anyone else. There is nothing to be gained by trying to measure our "goodness" nor in comparing it to others. Our focus should be on how well we are trying to follow Jesus and leave the rest in the hands of our merciful God. "Your way, O Lord, make known to me; teach me your paths." Psalm 25:4
