The ND Choose Life Committee, through their Absentee Ballot Project, is distributing Absentee/Mail Ballot Application Forms so anyone wanting to make sure their vote gets counted can vote early.

To protect the laws that we, as ND residents, have already voted for To protect our State's Constitution, as it is written, from being altered by any out of state pro-choice agencies, And finally, To insure that our State remains a pro-life State.

Our legislators, drew up this amendment in order to make sure our pro-life laws are protected from being twisted or misunderstood as to what we, as ND citizens, have already declared to be our intent.
