Scrip Profit Report: Bishop Ryan Catholic School earned **\$21,733.91** in Scrip rebates from Oct. thru December, (which is several thousand dollars lower than the same quarter last year). Out of that total, \$9780.25 was credited toward family tuitions; the remainder is the school's. Thank you to those who purchase Scrip regularly. We encourage everyone to use Scrip gift cards to pay for all your purchases of groceries, gas, household items, dining out, remodeling or building, or as gifts.
