AS CATHOLICS

Lent calls us into a season of solemnity and fasting. The Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) 540 explain that "by the solemn of forty days of Lent the Church unites herself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert." To aid in the solemnity of his season, St. Leo's Choir will be singing music more rooted in the Church's tradition. Beginning on Ash Wednesday, the Entrance Antiphon that is typically sing with the piano before Mass begins will replace the processional hymn as an Introit, and will eventually be sung in Latin towards the end of the Lenten season. We will also be singing a Gregorian Mass setting (Mass XVIII, Deus Genitor alme) which can be found in the Ignatius Pew Missal starting on page 26.

LENTEN GUIDELINES

On Fridays during Lent, people age 14 and older are required to refrain from meat. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of abstinence from meat and fasting for those between the ages of 18 and 59. Fasting means eating one full meal a day and allows two smaller meals that do not add up to a full meal. Catholics are encouraged to fast beyond these two days. We hope to see everyone at daily Mass.
