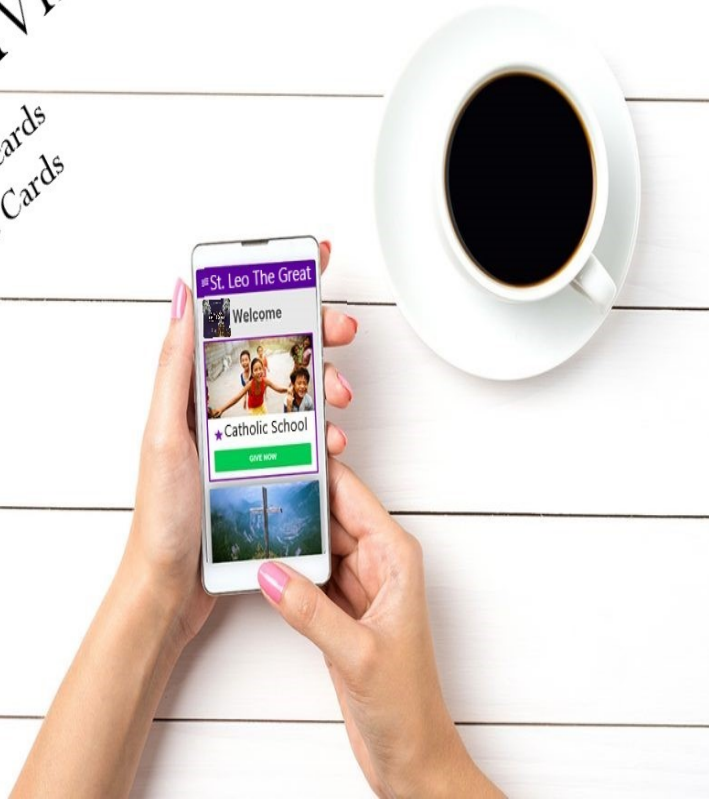

A word from the choir loft...

Dear parishioners,

We have all been deeply affected by the worldwide pandemic, but like you, the musicians in the choir loft are so glad to be back singing in our beautiful church! To better reflect the beauty and tradition our newly renovated church demonstrates, as well as to better adhere to what the Church teaches, St. Leo's Choir will be undergoing some minor changes. The Second Vatican Council says, "the Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services." (*Sacrosanctum concilium*, 116)

Therefore, out of obedience and reverence for the Church, St. Leo's will be singing a Gregorian Ordinary (Mass setting) in English during Ordinary Time. Ordinaries such as "The Mass of St. Philip Neri" or "The Mass of St. Leo the Great" will be reserved for more extraordinary seasons (Christmastide and Eastertide, respectively). The Ordinary that will be sung can be found in the Pew Missal, beginning on page 6.

In addition, the 9:30 A.M. mass, being the High Mass of the parish, will begin singing the Entrance Antiphon - which had been sung before mass begins - in its proper place: accompanying the procession of the clergy. 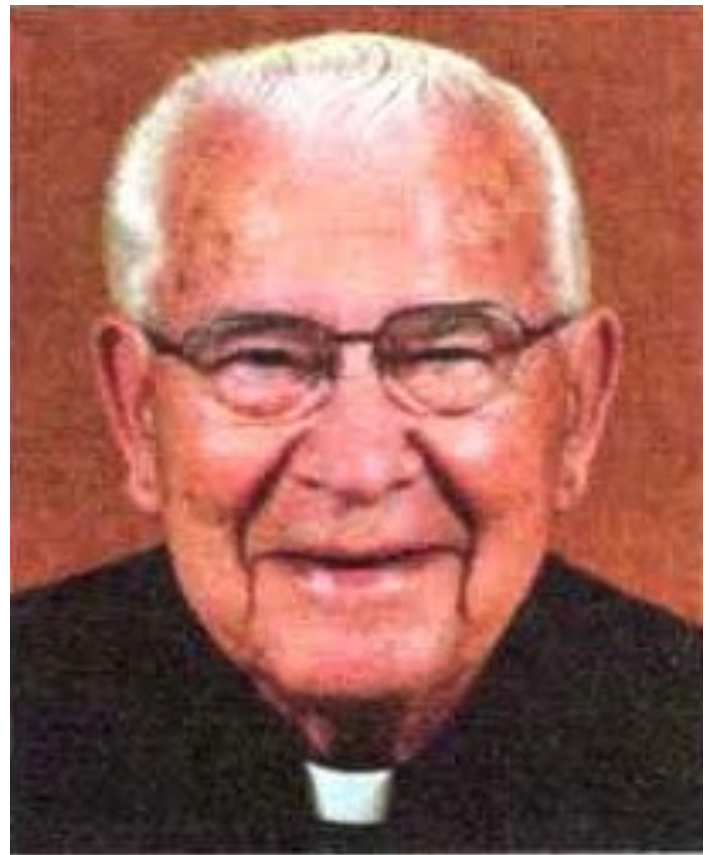
