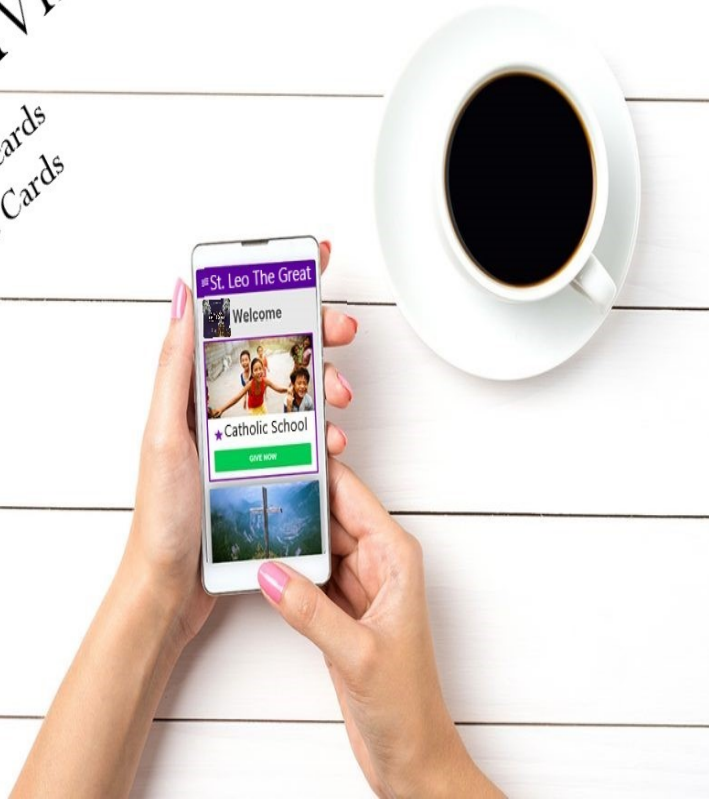

All Are Invited to a Citywide Eucharistic Procession

Minot, ND – Sunday, September 27th

A citywide Eucharistic Procession will be held on September 27th. The event will begin at 2 PM with an opening Mass at St. John the Apostle Catholic Church with a Eucharistic Procession to follow.

The route of the procession will begin at approximately 3:00 PM at St. John the Apostle, then proceed to St. Therese Church of the Little Flower, then to St. Leo the Great Catholic Church and end with Benediction at Our Lady of Grace Catholic Church. People may join at any of the church locations. The procession is prayerful, strictly non-political and family friendly. This event is open to the public, and all are encouraged to attend.

Designed to help bring peace, prayer, and healing to our nation through the Eucharistic Presence of our Lord Jesus Christ, this event is being planned by local parishioners. Clergy will lead the procession, and everyone is invited to pray the rosary for all fifty states.

The route is approximately 1½ miles between the churches. Parking is available at each church. Participants should plan for their own transportation back to the location of their vehicles. If no option is available for return transportation, bus transportation will be available.

If you are not able to walk in the procession, Eucharistic Adoration will be held in each parish during the procession. Times for Adoration will vary at each parish, please contact the office and check the bulletins or websites for specific times.
