### **Procession and Feast of St. Joseph the Worker**

In this year of St. Joseph, the Bismarck-Mandan Troops of St. George and knights of Columbus invite all to participate in a procession of the image of St. Joseph, Patron of the Church, from St. Joseph's Church in Mandan to the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Bismarck, where the image will be permanently installed.
