Mark your calendars! A city-wide Eucharistic Procession will be held (weather permitting) on **Sunday June 6** – The Feast of Corpus Christi (Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ). This family-friendly event is open to the public.

The event will begin with a **2pm Mass at Our Lady of Grace Church**.
