## FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

#### **June 3: St. Charles Lwanga and Companions, Martyrs.**

Owing to religious hatred, many faithful Christians were killed in Uganda by King Mwangi (a pedophile) during the years 1885-1887. Among them Charles Lwanga and his twenty-one companions, adhering steadfastly to the Catholic faith were put to death, some by sword, others by burning, because they would not accede to the king's unreasonable and immoral demands. St. Charles is the patron saint of African youth.

#### **June 5: St. Boniface, Bishop and Martyr**

St. Boniface was born in England about the year 673. He was professed in the monastic life at Exeter but in 719 went to Germany to preach the Gospel. While preaching the Gospel to the Frisians (a Germanic ethnic group indigenous to the coastal parts of the Netherlands and northwestern Germany), St. Boniface was killed by pagans in 754. He is the patron saint of Germany.

#### **June 6: St. Norbert, Bishop**

St. Norbert was born in the duchy of Cleves around the year 1080. He was converted from a worldly life and, embracing the religious state, was ordained to the priesthood in 1115. He was elected Archbishop of Magdeburg in 1126 and reformed the Christian life and spread the faith to nearby pagan nations. He died in 1134. He is the patron saint of safe delivery in childbirth.
