FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

July 15 – St. Bonaventure

Saint **Bonaventure** (1221 – 15 July 1274)
(born **Giovanni di Fidanza**), was an Italian medieval
Franciscan scholastic, theologian, and philosopher.
Healed from a childhood disease through the prayers
of Saint Francis of Assisi, Bonaventure joined
the Order of Friars Minor at age 22. The
seventh Minister General of the Order of Friars Minor,
he was also Cardinal Bishop of Albano.

He was canonized on 14 April 1482 by Pope Sixtus
IV and declared a Doctor of the Church in the year
1588 by Pope Sixtus V. He is known as the "Seraphic
Doctor" and is the patron saint against intestinal
problems.

July 16 - Our Lady of Mount Carmel is the title
given to the Blessed Virgin Mary in her role
as patroness of the Carmelite Order. The first
Carmelites were Christian hermits living on Mount
Carmel in the Holy Land during the late 12th and early
to mid-13th century. They built in the midst of their
hermitages a chapel which they dedicated to the
Blessed Virgin, whom they conceived of in chivalric
terms as the "Lady of the place." Our Lady of Mount
Carmel was adopted in the 19th century as the patron
saint of Chile, in South America.

Since the 15th century, popular devotion to Our Lady
of Mount Carmel has centered on the Scapular of Our
Lady of Mount Carmel, also known as the Brown
Scapular. Traditionally, Mary is said to have given the
Scapular to an early Carmelite named Saint Simon
Stock (1165-1265).
