**July 22 – St. Mary Magdalene** St. Mary Magdalene is one of the greatest saints of the Bible and a legendary example of God's mercy and grace. The precise dates of her birth and death are unknown, but we do know she was present with Christ during his public ministry, death and resurrection. She is mentioned at least a dozen times in the Gospels. During Jesus' ministry, it is believed that Mary Magdalene followed him, part of a semi-permanent entourage who served Jesus and his Disciples.

Mary was present at the crucifixion and was the first to see Christ after he rose from the dead, visiting his tomb to anoint his body only to find the stone rolled away. It was she who announced the resurrection to the apostles.

She is the patroness of converts, repentant sinners, pharmacists, tanners and women, and many other places and causes.

**July 25 – St. James the Apostle**, also called **James, son of Zebedee**, or **James the Greater**, (born, Galilee, Palestine—died 44 CE, Jerusalem), one of the Twelve Apostles, distinguished as being in Jesus' innermost circle and the only apostle whose martyrdom is recorded in the New Testament (Acts 12:2).

As a member of the inner circle, James witnessed the raising of Jairus' daughter (Mark 5:37, Luke 8:51), the Transfiguration (Mark 9:2), and Jesus' agony in the Garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14:33, Matthew 26:37). James and John asked Jesus to let them sit, one at his right and one at his left, in his future glory (Mark 10:35–40), a favor that Jesus said was not his to grant.

James was beheaded by order of King Herod Agrippa I of Judaea; according to Spanish tradition, his body was taken to Santiago de Compostela, where his shrine attracts pilgrims from all over the world. He is the patron saint of Spain and pilgrims.
