**July 29 – St. Martha,** sister of Lazarus and Mary of Bethany, she was a model of hospitality and a faithful disciple. She confessed her faith in Jesus as the Son of God when he came to her home after the death of Lazarus (Chapter 11 of John's Gospel). She is the patroness of housewives, waiters, and waitresses.

**July 31 – St. Ignatius of Loyola** Born Inigo Lopez de Loyola in 1491, the man known as Ignatius of Loyola entered the world in Loiola, Spain. The founder of the Jesuits was on his way to military fame and fortune when a cannon ball shattered his leg. Because there were no books of romance on hand during his convalescence, Ignatius whiled away the time reading a life of Christ and lives of the saints. His conscience was deeply touched, and a long, painful turning to Christ began. After a period of great peace of mind, he went through a harrowing trial of scruples. There was no comfort in anything—prayer, fasting, sacraments, penance. At length, his peace of mind returned.

It was during this year of conversion that Ignatius began to write down material that later became his greatest work, the *Spiritual Exercises*.

In 1534, at the age of 43, he and six others—one of whom was Saint Francis Xavier—vowed to live in poverty and chastity and to go to the Holy Land. This became impossible, so they vowed to offer themselves to the apostolic service of the pope. Ignatius stayed in Rome. The other six traveled into various mission territories. Ignatius' passed away on July 31, 1556, at the age of 64. He was beatified by Pope Paul V on July 27, 1609 and canonized on March 12, 1622. He is the patron saint of the Society of Jesus, soldiers, educators and education.

**AUGUST 1 – ST. ALPHONSUS LIGUORI,** BISHOP, DOCTOR of the church founded the Redemptorists order. Alphonsus is best known for his moral theology, but he also wrote well in the field of spiritual and dogmatic theology. His *Glories of Mary* is one of the great works on that subject, and his book *Visits to The Blessed Sacrament* went through 40 editions in his lifetime, greatly influencing the practice of this devotion in the church. Saint Alphonsus Liguori is the patron saint of theologians and vocations.
