FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

January 27 – St. Angela Merici – Angela has the double distinction of founding the first teaching congregation of women in the Church and what is now called a “secular institute” of religious women.

St. Angela was born in 1470 in the territory of Lombardy, Italy. She became a Third Order Franciscan and called together girls whom she instructed in charitable works. In 1535 under the patronage of St. Ursula, she founded a congregation of women who instructed poor girls in the Christian life. The idea of a teaching congregation of women was new and took time to develop. The community thus existed as a “secular institute” until some years after Angela’s death. She died in 1540 and is the patron saint of the sick, disabled, and physically challenged.

January 28 – St. Thomas Aquinas – See insert. He is the patron saint of Catholic schools, colleges, and students.

January 31 – St. John Bosco – See insert but also go to formed.org to watch two movies about him. He is the patron saint of boys, youth, and editors.
