FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

February 10 – St. Scholastica, twin sister of St. Benedict, was born in Nursia, Italy about the year 480. She vowed herself to God and followed her brother to Monte Cassino where she founded a religious order for women. She died there around the year 547.

February 11 – Our Lady of Lourdes – In 1858 the Virgin Mary appeared to Bernadette Soubirous near Lourdes in France within the cave of Massabielle. Through this humble girl, Mary revealed herself as “The Immaculate Conception”. Bernadette said the apparition asked her to dig in the ground and drink from the spring she found there. This made her disheveled and some of her supporters were dismayed, but this act revealed the stream that soon became a focal point for pilgrimages. Lourdes water has become a focus of devotion to the Virgin Mary at Lourdes. Since the apparitions, many people have claimed to have been cured by drinking or bathing in it, and the Lourdes authorities provide it free of charge to any who ask for it.

February 14 – Sts Cyril and Methodius – St. Cyril and St. Methodius were brothers from Thessalonica. They preached the faith in Moravia and prepared Slavic liturgical texts in what would subsequently be known as the Cyrillic alphabet. Both were summoned to Rome, where Cyril died on February 14, 869. Methodius was consecrated bishop and went to Pannonia where he tirelessly preached the Gospel. Though suffering much from detractors he received assistance from the Popes. He died on April 6, 885 in Velehrad, Czechoslovakia.
