FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

February 21 – St. Peter Damian

a reforming Benedictine monk and cardinal in the
circle of Pope Leo IX. Dante placed him in one of
the highest circles of Paradiso as a great predecessor
of Saint Francis of Assisi. St. Peter was one of the
chief forerunners of the Hildebrandine reform in the
Church. His preaching was most eloquent and his
writing voluminous. He was declared a Doctor of
the Church in 1828.

February 22 – The Chair of St. Peter

Early martyrologies indicate that two liturgical
feasts were celebrated in Rome, centuries before the
time of Charles the Bald, in honor of earlier chairs
associated with Saint Peter, one of which was kept
in the baptismal chapel of St. Peter's Basilica, the
other at the catacomb of Priscilla. The dates of these
celebrations were January 18 and February 22. The
feasts thus became associated with an abstract
understanding of the "Chair of Peter", which
by synecdoche signifies the episcopal office of
the Pope as Bishop of Rome, an office considered to
have been first held by Saint Peter, and thus
extended to the diocese, the See of Rome.
