Compose a social media message your grandparents might have posted when they were your age (if social media had existed).

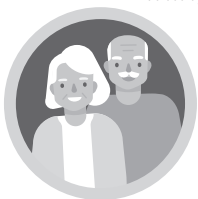
Interview a grandparent or other older relative or close family friend via video chat. Record the conversation for your family archives.
